




## Whoshould taxplan?

## Tax Planning Questions

- 3 How are upcoming tax law changes going to affect my tax obligations? Should I take any action to prepare now?
  - How would any anticipated changes in my filing status affect my tax situation next year?

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- Am I maxing out my options to save on taxes through funding a retirement savings accounts?
  - Do I have any carryovers to offset future tax liabilities?

- 7 What are my best options to save for future college tuition & expenses?
  - If I sell or buy a home this year, what are the tax implications? Would I be able to exclude any of the profits from the capital gains tax?
- 9 Would it make sense to open an FSA or HSA?

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- 10 Are there any new tax credits I could qualify for based on my income or dependents next year?
- 11 Am I able to make any tax-free gifts this year?
- 12 Should I be taking any steps to plan to protect my wealth for future generations?
- 13 I may be inheriting \_\_\_\_\_, how would this affect me from a tax perspective?
  - Is there anything else I could be doing to lower my taxable income?
